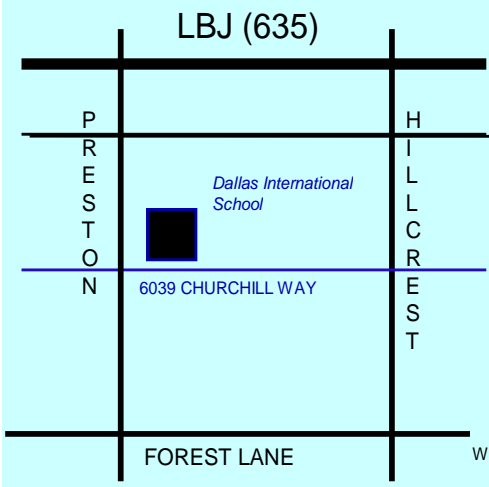
Summer Enrichment Camp

The **Summer Enrichment Camp** offered by the **DIS Language Institute** is a 6-week camp open to all. Every week, a choice of activities is proposed. The students can compose their own program which may consist of a half-day or a full-day of language learning, creative arts workshop, karate camp or mad science lab.

Through our **language immersion, creative arts, sports** and **science** camps we hope to encourage the natural sense of wonder that children possess, by giving them the opportunity to explore different countries, cultures, and ideas while making new friends.

Our groups are structured by age and, in the case of language workshops, **by level of fluency**. The students are required to attend a **minimum of three weeks** out of the six. Enrollment does not have to be for consecutive weeks even though it is our recommendation.

Morning camps meet from **9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.** Afternoon camps **begin at 12:30 and release at 3:30 p.m.** A monitored lunch is provided at no additional cost for the students who attend the full day program. Before and After camp care is also available for an additional fee. No uniform is required.



Our campus is located in north Dallas, off of Preston Rd, just south of LBJ Freeway (I-635).

From I-75 north (or south), exit I-635 west. Take the Hillcrest Rd. exit and turn left. Turn right on Churchill Way. The school is on the right.

From I-635 east, exit Preston Rd. and turn right. Turn left on Churchill Way. The school is immediately on the left.

Languages	Chinese, French, Spanish, ESL (English as a Second Language)
Children Ages : 3-10 Chinese, French, Spanish, ESL	In these groups shaped according to age and language ability , the children engage in a variety of fun activities using the target language as a means of communication. They learn vocabulary and sentence structure but also traditional games and songs. Arts and crafts as well as other physical activities such as yoga or gymnastics are included in the program.
Teen Language Workshop Ages : 11-17 French, Spanish, ESL	These language workshops are conducted by native speakers using interactive methods. While the main focus is on conversation, all four skills (speaking, writing, listening comprehension and reading comprehension) are covered. Upon completion of a 3-week session, the students receive a certificate.
Adult Language Workshop Chinese, French, Spanish	A wonderful opportunity for parents to bond with their children as they share in the experience of learning a new language. These half-day group classes encourage conversation in the language being learned and provide a fun and relaxed environment for interactive learning. Classes meet Monday through Friday.
Mad Science	Robotics, rockets, forensics, ...
Welcome to the Garden Ages: 3-5	Our little scientists will discover how science moves the world around us. They will make a magical crystal garden, dissect owl pellets, dye chromatography t-shirts and much more.
Moving with Science Ages: 7-9	This camp covers multiple areas of science, from biology, to engineering, to chemistry. Campers build bridges and other structures one day, then build a camera obscura the next. They will delve into the science of circuits and sensors. Each day of camp includes activities where campers create amazing things to take home with them.
Rockin' Rockets Ages: 7-9	Blast-off your knowledge of aerodynamics and flight. This camp is an intense, exciting study on rockets. Campers build their very own rockets and planes. They experiment with different kinds of propulsion systems. And they definitely launch and recover rockets! Each day of camp includes activities where campers create amazing things to take home with them.
Bubble, Smoke, Explosion Ages: 7-12	Our little scientists will have fun with chemistry in this exciting camp. They will make a magical crystal garden, watch as smoke bellows from the NASA-styled rocket they will build in class. They will learn about our solar system and make a comet using everyday items. All this and a lot more!
Red Hot Robots Ages: 9-12	In this half-day camp, the children will learn all about the use of robotics in our world today and how technology will continue to affect our future. Campers will check out sound sensing robots, line tracking robots, amphibious robots, and even robots that play soccer. Over the course of the camp, they will build their own working robot to take home.
Secret Agent Lab Ages: 9-12	Hours of fun-filled, hands-on CSI themed science activities. Discover fingerprinting, figure out the science of forensics, become a super spy, ... find out WHODUNIT ... and become a code breaker. Go under cover and discover the secrets of the Secret Agent .
Arts	Ceramics, painting, drama, creative writing
Art Time Ages : 7-12	Through the exploration of different art forms such as ceramics, painting and collage students will learn to express their creativity. Groups will be arranged by age.
Clay Time Ages: 6-12	The children will explore the different techniques of hand-building: coil, slab, and pinching while using their creativity and acquiring a sense of space, form, and structure. While having lots of fun, they will also discover the array of possibilities to treat work surface.
Spanish Drama Ages: 6-12	Designed for students who already speak Spanish at an intermediate-advanced level this workshop will focus on developing presentation skills (diction, improvisation) and building confidence. Activities will include performing easy plays, poems and songs.
Writer's Den Ages: 7-12	This creative writing workshop conducted in English will develop your child's natural interest in writing through the use of stimulating activities and exciting projects.
Sports	Karate
Karate Dojo Ages: 7-12	This half-day karate camp will combine traditional karate classes, karate games and self-defense techniques. An emphasis is placed on creating a safe and fun environment.
