



ENROLLMENT

2010-2011 Soccer Programs

Players from age 4 and up can be enrolled in the DIS Soccer Program. Beginners can be accepted at any age, but might have a progressive and adapted involvement in games for at least a season.

Enrollment will cover the **full year** for 35 weeks of practices, or a **half year** from August to December 15 or January to May 27. An optional 3vs3 league can be added but will not affect the practice scheme. Available to everybody, 8 games season guarantee.

Fall and/or spring leagues will be included in the basic program. Parents have to sign a pledge of conduct at enrollment, and the program is open to **non-DIS** students who will then also be automatically covered by the School's insurance.

Program Fee will be:

- \$260/520 for Maternelle 2 (U5) + \$55 for winter season 3vs3 (optional)
- \$295/590 for Maternelle 3 (U6) + \$55 for winter season 3vs3 (optional)
- \$380/760 for Primary (U7 to U10) + \$75 for winter season 3vs3 (optional)
- \$400/800 for Secondary (U11 to U15)
+ \$75 for winter season 3vs3 (optional)

Uniforms:



Game uniforms can be purchased at DIS for \$40 including White & Royal Blue Jersey, shorts and Tiger Logo Patch. **Practice Jerseys** can be ordered directly from the Spirit store. Soccer shoes (no long cleats to enable indoor in Gym), shin guards (mandatory) and white socks will be supplied by parents.

TEAMS and LEAGUES

Teams will be established with respect of **skills** or **ages** whenever required, also taking into account the **commitment** and **competitive** level expected from parents and coaches.

North Dallas offers various Leagues with pure recreational or more competitive divisions, while select level is only after 10 years old. The **age requirement** is a key factor to select the appropriate divisions, as we know that DIS usually has younger children than other school at comparable grade.



Seasons will still be in fall and spring, with an indoor winter or summer program being offered as an option only. Each season covers **8-10 games**, not counting friendly scrimmage or tournaments.

In most of the Leagues where we have our teams, the **50% playtime rule** applies, among others. It is important that teams respect this obligation at least over the season, if not on a game- by-game basis. The number of players per team will be limited accordingly.

Rescheduling games for rainout will often be on weekdays, with sufficient notice and acceptance by the team or coach. The Program will try to avoid games scheduled during our school breaks, and the season basic schedule can be heavily affected by inclement weather.

COACHING

Curriculum: Progression steps from 5 years old to select levels will be identified and used as a measurement of performance of athletic, mental or technical development. Players will receive a consistent training across the whole program, whoever is managing the team, based on the curriculum established by the coaching staff. Team coaches and skills trainers will work together to correct weaknesses observed during games.

Team coaching: to insure proper presence at games, better connection with players and follow-up on individual development, we will limit the number of teams per coach to **2**, while still making them available for backup as required. For practices, a group of more than 15 will have a second coach to assist whenever possible.

Skills Classes: each player will be invited to a skills class one hour per week, not necessarily connected with his or her team practice.

Private tutoring skills: private skills sessions will be available. Parents will have to enroll separately and pay directly for them.

Discipline: Coaches are considered like DIS Teachers, and will apply a strict discipline as required by player's behavior, during both games and practice sessions.



Clear Objectives: based on parent and school expectations, coaches will be given objectives and measurement which could vary from team to team, like individual development, playtime, or winning ratio. Our coaches will be able to adjust to both recreational and competitive level, based on background and league experience. Our coaches will also ensure the promotion of our most advanced players, 12 years old and up, to the best academies in North Dallas, for those willing to join Select soccer.

PRACTICE and TRAINING

Two practice sessions will be offered to each team: a team practice and a skills class, not necessarily with the same coach. A **double practice time** will ensure there is at least one session per week in case of inclement weather or other conflicting activity.

A group of more than 15 children will have a **second coach** to assist whenever possible. Teams can share practice time and field depending on age and location.

For CE2 and up, also based on each team's choice, team practice will be performed on an **outside field** to give players conditions similar to their weekend games. **Parent carpooling** will be required, as DIS cannot provide group transportation. DIS will reserve fields as close as possible to the school.



In addition, DIS is looking for **inclement weather indoor alternatives** in a nearby Indoor facility. This ad hoc solution is expensive and based upon availability. It also requires parent carpooling. The DIS Gym will also be used several times per week. DIS classrooms will also be used to discuss soccer tactics and videos.

Make-up days will be offered to reach 30 sessions a year, or 15 a season minimum

Special Sessions will also be offered: goalkeeping, overall knowledge of Soccer, etc.
